  - The first recital, performed May 10, 2016, was part of "The Promise of the Vatican Library Conference" hosted at the University of Notre Dame. The majority of works chosen for this program were works with manuscripts in the Vatican Library. The concert featured the music of Josquin, Domenico Scarlatti, Vivaldi, and the anonymous oratorio O cecità del misero mortale from the Vatican's Barberini Collection.
  - The second recital, performed April 9, 2017, featured motets of Bach, Barber, Bruckner, 0 Victoria, and Weelkes. This program was coached in a choral/conducting masterclass on April 7, 2017 by Stephen Cleobury from King's College, Cambridge.
  - The third and final recital, performed February 4, 2018 featured Mozart's "Great" Mass in C minor, K. 427 performed with full orchestra and chorus in Notre Dame's Basilica of the Sacred Heart. This program's preparation was mentored by Ann Howard Jones, Professor Emerita, Boston University.
- Coached singers and conducted a multidisciplinary performance of Dieterich Buxtehude's Membra Jesu Nostri with a group of student soloists from Sacred Music at Notre Dame along with a professional viol consort.
- Coached singers and conducted two works of J.S. Bach, *Du wahrer Gott und Davids Sohn*, and *Jesu*, meine Freude as a part of two Vespers services at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church in South Bend.
